

Booking Conditions for Hire of Miskin Mill Buildings & Campsite Facilities.

An Inspection will take place on arrival & departure of all facilities used.

The hirer is responsible for ensuring that all facilities used are left in a clean & tidy state.

All lights & equipment to be turned off unless otherwise advised.

Careful use of lights & heating (shut doors etc) should be undertaken.

All general rubbish to be left in Wheelie Bins - All recyclable items should be disposed of in recycling bags (provided).

Before leaving the site ensure that all doors & windows are locked.

Vehicles to be parked in car park ONLY, the barrier to be closed whenever possible.

Report any damage ASAP. In the first instance please contact the duty member of the team looking after you – if they are not available please refer to the list of names and telephone numbers situated in cottage, mill and toilet block.

We regret we cannot allow any of the following on site: - **Fireworks, Guns or Firearms, Dogs, Caravans or Alcohol.**

Conserve Wood – use only dead or fallen

wood from woodland area, return unused wood to campfire area – please do not leave it in or near the shelters. If using campfire circle please use wood appropriately.

Litter sweep before departure.

Outside showers / toilets, if you use them please clean them.

Campers -Wet Pit; use ‘Wet Bucket’ or ‘Plastic Bag’ with holes. Cottage / Mill when disposing of greasy water please use main drain only – dispose of any fat in plastic bags and place in Wheelie Bin.

Consider neighbours /other site users keep noise to a Minimum at night.

Leaving inspection, hand back keys/folder/ pay fees/ **Whole site Bookings - ensure leaders remain until site inspection takes place.**

Deposits are Non-refundable for all cancellations within 3 months of arrival date. Fees are payable on departure unless otherwise agreed.

Hirer is responsible for the costs of any breakages.

If you are including an unusual activity such as Archery or an activity that is not a usual Scout / Guide Activity please inform the Booking Secretary as the other users of the site will need to be informed.

Lighting and hot water throughout the site and central heating in lodge & mill are included in your general charges.
